Code of Conduct for Players

As a player for the Diesel Baseball Club, I agree to:

- Respect my manager and coaches. The managers and coaches are volunteers who donate their time to our organization and my appreciation of their help should be reflected in all my actions on the playing field. Instructors provided and paid by Diesel Baseball Club are to be afforded the same respect as managers and coaches. Directions of managers, coaches and instructors are to be obeyed at all times.
- Respect my team members and other players. I will not insult, criticize or verbally abuse any other player.
- Players are to respect and appreciate all facilities and equipment provided for and funded by Diesel Baseball Club. Abuse of equipment or a facility will not be tolerated.
- Never resort to physical threats or actions to rectify a situation. Physical outbursts are unacceptable and will be dealt with using a zero-tolerance policy.
- Display good sportsmanship at all times. As a representative of the Diesel Baseball Club, it is my duty to reflect the characteristics of fair play at all times. I will display to others that competition is healthy.
- It is DBC policy that player involvement with other organizations is prohibited. This is a zero tolerance policy that will be strictly enforced without exception. Diesel players that are offered participation in a college or major league baseball sponsored showcase via personal invite only, may apply to the general manager of DBC for approved participation. (DBC will not consider boiler plate flyer invitations or paid participation in a showcase as events that fall under this category.) It is the goal of DBC to aid and assist all players in furtherance of their careers. It is the core and foundation of DBC to provide it's players with a platform to display their talents and those who do not adopt and adhere to these goals are free to play with other organizations with good wishes.

Code of Conduct for Parents

As a parent of a player for the Diesel Baseball Club, I agree to:

- Respect the managers and their coaching staff. Managers and coaches are volunteers who donate their time and expertise to the Diesel Baseball Club.
- Instructors provided for and paid by Diesel Baseball Club are to be afforded the same respect as managers and coaches.
- Respect all players. All players are contributors to a team and should be positively encouraged by all parents. I will not engage in insults or criticisms of players.
- Display good sportsmanship at all times.
- Appreciate that the Diesel Baseball Club is striving to provide the best baseball program. The programs of the Diesel Baseball Club are intended to be learning and fun experiences for all players.
